#### What is NEW coming to the BFA?

A creation from Ryan Carlton is on the horizon, as most balloon pilots have come to appreciate Ryan this is exciting news for BFA members!

The "BFA Event Registration System" (or until we come up with a snappier name, BFA Events for short) is in the works. The design and feature list are not finalized, but what Ryan has planned in general is; the idea of the system is to provide a centralized, standardized location for event organizers to post new event listings and for balloon pilots to submit applications to these events.

This will allow organizers to benefit from features, such as:

- Credit card entry fee processing
- Automatically generated FSIMS reports
- Document validation at-a-glance
- Easy contact with pilots

Pilots will also benefit from added features, such as:

- Auto filled answers for most common application questions: enter once and they are remembered
- Notifications when your documents near expiration
- Support for multiple balloons and multiple pilots/balloon
- · Easily search for events to attend

Progress is on track to start closed testing in March (mostly looking for technical bugs, patching any security holes, etc.). We will later have an open round of beta-testing where we will invite all users to try out the system. Ryan's goal is to have the official release by next January 2020!

Thank you, Ryan for all your hard work to make life easier for all of us!!!
