





Looking for Resources to Help with Your Flying Proficiency?

The FAA, you know the agency we love to hate, has developed their WINGS **Program** to address accident causal factors that plague the general aviation community. The Wings Program is not a simple "Award" program but is instead a true proficiency program, designed to help improve our skills and knowledge as pilots.

The **WINGS** - Pilot Proficiency Program is based on the premise that pilots who maintain currency and proficiency in the basics of flight will enjoy a safer and more stress-free flying experience. When joining the program, you select the category and class of aircraft in which you wish to receive training and in which you wish to demonstrate your flight proficiency.

The program encourages pilots to develop their own on-going training program that provides an opportunity to fly on a regular basis with an authorized flight instructor. The program is most effective if the training is accomplished regularly throughout the year, thus affording you the opportunity to fly in different seasons and in different flight conditions.

Reviewing and refreshing your knowledge is just as important as actual flying. To meet this goal, we provide you many opportunities to complete online courses, attend seminars and other events, and participate in webinars. While you will find courses and activities for all types of pilots, fixed wing, rotor, glider, and remote pilots, some of the knowledge courses and activities that are focused on the ballooning community include but are not limited to:

- Lighter than Air Outreach Series Propane/Fire Safety
- Balloon Aeronautical Decision Making
- Lighter than Air Outreach Series Airport Communications
- ADM for LTA Free Balloons
- Hot Air Balloon Maintenance for Pilots

Additionally, there are outlines for flight activities that can be used when conducting a flight review or proficiency check. These include but are not limited to:

- Flying Skills (Comm'l, PVT, Sport Pilot)
- Preflight Planning and Preparation (Pvt, Comm'l)
- Preflight Planning & Preparation & Launches & Landing (Comm'l, PVT, Sport Pilot)

It is important to note that completion of any Phase of WINGS (three knowledge activities and three flight activities) satisfies the requirement for a flight review. So not only will you complete a review of the most common weak areas that have led others to the accident site, but you end up with a flight review, as well!

Head on over to www.FAASafety.gov and look at the wealth of programs that are focused on keeping you proficient as a pilot.


