# **Rules Changes for 2020**

We always try to highlight the rules changes that will most affect pilots throughout the next flying season. This year there were no major rules changes that will affect pilots at events. A few areas where you will find changes are:

- 1. Section II goal selection
- 2. Section III Conduct
- 3. Appendix A Code of Conduct

We always encourage members to read through and understand all the rules but these areas you may want to make sure to look at.

#### **New JR Membership Fees**

The HACD has put into place a new fee structure for JR members. Anyone under the age of 30 at the start of the calendar year may purchase a JR membership for \$35.00. This membership grants you all the privileges of membership: NEL recognition, competing at state, regional, and national levels, and world team selection. So JR's make sure to take advantage of the new payment structure!

#### Life Memberships

Life memberships will once again be available! To follow the BFA and other divisions the HACD Board has put into place a permanent life membership option. For \$550.00 you may become a life time pilot member to the division. For \$150.00 you may become a life time officials member. Please consider this as you renew your membership this year.

#### **Document Management System**

The BFA is in the process of putting together a system that would allow pilots to fill in all pertinent information needed by hot air balloon events. This database then could be accessed by events instead of the pilots filling out multiple applications for the events they attend. This database is still under construction. We will update you on the database and its progress.
