The US Team National Hot Air Balloon Championship will be hosted in Shreveport, Louisiana June 8-13, 2021 by the Shreveport-Bossier Sports Commission. The formal invitation and application are under construction. "A-Rated" pilots will be the first to receive an application and they will have the opportunity to register a team by December 31, 2020.

In the inaugural year, the Championship is limited to ten 3-member teams and consequently the pilot selection process required a different approach. In a manner similar to the US Nationals, where the selection process is based on NEL performance, a ranking method was developed to rank the "A" pilots based on a point system determined using statistics of World and US National Championships and top 10 NEL rankings. While there are a number of pilots on the A-ranked list that are not currently competing, this list will serve as our starting point.

"A" ranked pilots are those meeting the following criteria:

- Any past National Champion (US, Women's, and Juniors)
- Any World competition podium finisher
- Any pilot finishing in the top ten of the US National Championship two or more times in the last five (2016-2020) years.

A-ranked pilots eligible to register a team for the 2021 US Team National Championship in order of priority are as follows. Duplicate numbers indicate a tie for the position. Registrants must be current BFA and HACD members.

If less than 10 A-ranked pilots register a team, B-ranked pilots will have an opportunity to captain and register a team. "B" ranked pilots are those meeting the following criteria:

• Any pilot having participated in a US Nationals or World Championship two (2) or more times in the past five (5) years (2016-2020) not classified as an "A" and have finished in the top 50 of the NEL two or more times in the past five years.

• Any pilot finishing in the top fifteen (15) of the BFA NEL in three (3) of the last five (5) years.
