

2016 Seminar Webinar now available online

If you missed out on attending a BFA-sanctioned continuing education seminar, or you missed the BFA's Seminar Webinar, streamed on March 12th, then you'll want to take advantage of this option just announced by the BFA board. The 2016 Seminar-Webinar video is now available on-line for viewing for free; however, you must log-on before accessing the Education and Training tab.

In order to be submitted to insurance for credit purposes, you must register and pay the registration fee which is \$50 for BFA Pilots and \$35 for BFA Crew.

If you are taking the complete course for insurance credit, write the down the "secret word" displayed during the video (1 per session). When complete, go back to Seminar Registration and click on EVALUATION/TEST (upper right menu) to take the short guiz.

Be sure to record the "secret word", and go back to Seminar Registration to take the completion test in order to get your information sent to your insurance company. To access the videos, go to bfa.net, log in, and then select "programs."



Michael is survived by his wife Keely




